We can no longer park in the neighboring yard. Park along the street and carpool if you possibly can.

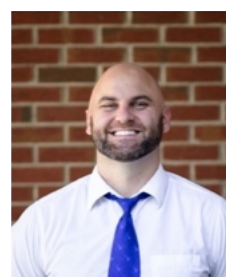


It's a Girl!

Verse of the Week: Psalm 101:2 NASB 1995

"I will give heed to the blameless way. When will You come to me? I will walk within my house in the integrity of my heart."



This week we will be talking about trust-killers. Trust is built slowly and destroyed quickly. Psalm 101 contains the views of a king striving for integrity and searching for it in his land. He values "faithfulness," but despises a "perverse heart," "slander," "arrogance," "deceit," "lies," "wickedness," and "evildoers."

This psalm is a great starting point when discussing those terrible behaviors that kill trust in a person, family, or church. Let's make sure we banish these vices far from us.
