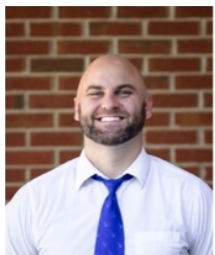


Welcome Going Family!

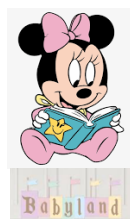
